PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall Resolution No. 2008-1 of Alfalfa County, Oklahoma entitled:

A resolution providing for the general operations, fifty-five percent (55%) of the total revenue generated for purposes pertaining to the health and well-being of the people, including the personal services, maintenance, and general operations of the Alfalfa County Emergency Medical Services. Twenty-two and one-half percent (22.5%) of the total revenue generated for the purpose of the general operations, personal services and improvements of the government and library of Alfalfa County. Twenty-two and one-half percent (22.5%) of the total revenue generated for purposes pertaining to the continued construction, personal services, maintenance, operation, and repair of the Alfalfa County Fairgrounds; levying a total two percent (2%) tax per dollar on the gross receipts or proceeds on certain sales, and herein defined; defining terms; prescribing procedures, remedies, liens and fixing penalties; fixing an effective date of January 1, 2009; limiting the life of said levy to 48 months, to expire on December 31, 2012; making provisions separable; and declaring an emergency be approved?

PROPOSITION NO. 2

Shall Resolution No. 2008-2 of Alfalfa County, Oklahoma, entitled:

A resolution which proposes that an Emergency Medical Service District, composed of all of Alfalfa County, be formed for the purpose of providing ambulance services to all county residents, with a special annual recurring ad valorem tax of three (3) mills on the dollar of assessed valuation being levied, in addition to all other levies, upon the assessed valuation of all taxable property in Alfalfa County, Oklahoma, real and personal, under the authority of Article 10, Section 9C of the Oklahoma Constitution, as amended, effective in the 2008 tax year, the proceeds of such levy to be used to provide funds to support, organize, operate, maintain, and finance the Emergency Medical Service District and its purpose of providing ambulance services to all county residents be approved?
